General Admit Overview

Students who have completed at least 6 credits in the semester prior to application, have a cumulative 3.0 cumulative GPA at the time of application, and a 3.0 cumulative science GPA are eligible for General admit status. George Fox Students pursuing General Admission must complete the [Intent to Pursue Nursing](#). Failure to complete the Intent to Pursue Nursing form may result in not being evaluated for the current admission cycle.

Running Start students: Running Start students must complete at least two continuous semesters (minimum of 12 credits per semester) at George Fox University before being considered for Direct Admission. Running start students with one semester (minimum of 12 credits per semester) at George Fox University and no additional college credits will be considered for General Admission. If a Running Start Student has additional college credit (earned after graduation from high school), they will be considered a transfer student and must apply via George Fox University.

General Admit Requirements

GFU students who do *not* qualify for Direct Admit status may still be eligible for a general admission option if all of the following requirements are met:

- Earn a minimum 3.00 Cumulative GPA at the time of application.
- Earn a minimum 3.00 Cumulative Science GPA, which includes the following courses: CHEM 150: General, Organic and Biological Chemistry, BIOL 221: Human Anatomy & Physiology I, BIOL 222: Human Anatomy and Physiology II, and BIOL 367: Microbiology at the time of application.
- Students must receive a C grade or higher in all nursing prerequisite courses. A C- grade or lower in any prerequisite course is not considered a passing grade and the course must be repeated.
- The total number of retakes and withdrawals may impact a student's consideration for admission to the nursing program. Retakes and withdrawals will be counted as follows:
 - If a course is retaken at GFU, the highest grade achieved in that course will be counted towards the student's GPA.
 - If a course is retaken at another institution, both the original grade at GFU and the grade(s) from the other institution will be combined to determine the final grade that is counted in the student's GPA.
 - If a student withdraws from a course, the withdrawal will be counted as a D grade and will be averaged with any subsequent retakes of the course unless the course is retaken at GFU.
- Must be enrolled at GFU with at least 6 credits in the semester prior to application to the nursing program and will be considered before Transfer students.
- Must meet the stated expectations for the GFU student body, as described in the GFU student handbook for being in good standing.
- Must have a social security number or visa number (per OSBN).
- Submit an [Intent to Pursue Nursing at George Fox University](#) form
 - **The form will be available on January 20th, 2025, and closes on April 25th, 2025.**
- Failure to complete the Intent to Pursue Nursing Form may result in not being evaluated for the current admission cycle.
- Attend an online group interview in late April or early May.

General Admit spaces are not guaranteed. Applicants will be offered admission based on a point system and space availability. The requirements listed above pertain to this particular admission cycle.
