

Direct Admit Overview

Students who are currently attending George Fox University and meet all of the following requirements are offered Direct Admission to the College of Nursing. Students must indicate their Intent to Pursue Nursing to be placed on the Direct Admit List. Failure to complete the Intent to Pursue form may result in not being evaluated for the current admission cycle.

Running Start students: Running Start students must complete at least two semesters (minimum of 12 credits per semester) at George Fox University before being considered for Direct Admission. Running start students with one semester (minimum of 12 credits per semester) at George Fox University and no additional college credits will be considered for General Admission. If a Running Start Student has additional college credit (earned after graduation from high school), they will be considered a transfer student and must apply via George Fox University.

Direct Admit Requirements

Pre-nursing majors are offered admission (*Direct Admit*) to the nursing program if all of the following requirements are met:

- Complete the four most recent semesters (fall and spring) at GFU with at least 12 credits per semester (a total of 48 credits in the past two years).
- Maintain a 3.0 cumulative nursing prerequisite science GPA *without* repeating any courses.
- Maintain a 3.0 cumulative nursing prerequisite GPA *without* repeating any courses.
- Receive a letter grade of “C” or higher in all nursing prerequisite courses. A grade of “C-” or lower (including pass/fail) will not be accepted.
- Submit an “Intent to Pursue Nursing at George Fox University” form
 - **The form will be available on August 19th, 2024, and will close on September 13th, 2024**
 - Failure to complete the Intent to Pursue Nursing Form may result in not being evaluated for the current admission cycle.

If more than 60 direct admit students qualify, some may be offered direct admission for a spring start.
